
Welcome to our pre-application community consultation on our plans for Ballydugan Retail Park.


Purpose of consultation and next steps

The purpose of this consultation is to share our proposals with the community and other interested parties, prior to the submission of a planning application to Newry, Mourne and Down District Council. Following this 12-week period of consultation, the feedback we receive will be shared with our design team and will help to shape our proposals prior to the submission of a planning application.

We will prepare a Pre-Application Community Consultation Report which will provide a summary of all feedback received, our response and how we have incorporated any appropriate feedback into the final proposals for the scheme.

This report will be submitted as part of our planning application to Newry, Mourne & Down District Council.

Severe flooding in late October 2023 caused substantial damage to the Asda store and adjacent retail units.

Following a detailed assessment of the damage, structural issues were identified that were deemed to be a hazard to human health and safety. A decision was therefore made to permanently close the existing superstore and retail units and replace them with new buildings.

On 25 January 2024 Asda opened a temporary store in the carpark of Ballydugan Retail Park. The 1,639 square metre temporary building, built in just eight weeks, provides the key everyday essentials across produce, meat and fish, frozen, grocery and beers, wines & spirits, offering a short-term solution for Asda's regular customers.









About the existing site


The application site is located at Ballydugan Retail Park within the settlement limit and town centre of Downpatrick. Irregular in shape with an approximate area of 5.1 hectares, the site comprises the existing Asda store, McDonalds and smaller retail units. The lands at the entrance to the site has planning permission for a replacement Petrol Filling Station.

Ards and Down Area Plan 2015

The Area Plan relative to the subject site is the Ards and Down Area Plan 2015, Map No. 3/002h Downpatrick Town Centre. It was adopted on 30 March 2009. The area plan map illustrates that the site lies within Downpatrick Town Centre on 'white or unzoned lands'.











We will shortly be submitting plans for a replacement Asda superstore and adjacent retail units at the Ballydugan **Retail Park.**

We propose to slightly change the layout of the retail park, with the Asda store located closer to the McDonalds unit and the non-food retail units situated adjacent to the undamaged non-food retail units to the north-west of the site.

Access to the retail park will remain unchanged.

Our proposals also include a new petrol filling station with shop on the site.

The table below sets out the existing and proposed floor space associated with the affected units. There are four non-food retail units and one drive through unit within the retail park that are not impacted by our

proposals.



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Site and Location Plans












ASDA
